

**Message to Residents from Larry Paz, President
February 25, 2010 Meeting Notes**

The official minutes are posted on the LAPOA Website and will be printed in the May issue of the Arrowhead News. The following notes, which do not reach the level of requiring formal minutes of actionable items under Robert's Rules of Order, are offered to all Property Owners.

Communications Coordination:

Great progress is being made on communication coordination. A presentation of the progress to date will be made at the March Property Owners Meeting.

Golf Outings Focus Group:

This group has proposed a strategy to bring golfers from nearby communities to play at Lake Arrowhead. A presentation is being prepared which will be shown at the March Property Owners meeting and to organizations in the area.

Covenants Focus Group:

This group has had its first meeting and is in the process of refining its purpose and scope to review our covenants to determine whether any changes should be considered and to explore methods for enforcement. A general approach will be presented at the March Property Owners Meeting.

Lake Committee:

The Lake Committee will be divided into three Groups to encompass all lake activities. The Lake Courtesy Patrol Group will provide volunteer on the water rescue services including a phone number for stranded boaters to call. The Conservation and Fishing Group will help to maintain the ecology of the lake. The Recreation Group coordinates activities that take place on the lake. The Conservation and Fishing Group is in the process of promoting the fishing tournament to be held in April. The goal is to reduce the population of large Pan fish helping to reduce completion for the food supply so more Black Bass can thrive. Entry fee \$5.00 per person. Open to Residents and their guests. As a fund raiser, they are seeking donated prizes in several categories.

Social Events:

This group has yet to begin their planning. Expectations are that it will commence in March.

Propane Consortium:

A number of ideas were presented on the approach to engage propane companies in bidding to serve our community with propane during the 2010/2011 heating season. The goal is to provide an attractive price and other benefits for all members. A major challenge is how to attract new members and serve those that do not own their own tanks.

Dumpsters:

A preliminary discussion was held to determine the parameters of promoting an LA cleanup program. No definitive decisions were made except to explore feasibility and funding possibilities.

Financial Reports:

An examination of the financial reports was made. Budget variances could generally be attributed to the following major factors: 1) Poor weather has impacted golf play even though we did hit budget. 2) The restaurant is significantly over budget. 3) Costs to address the cleanup required by recent storms.
